"Photo Aquarelle"



Andreas Altmann combines photography with artist painting or to be exact, with aquarelle. For him some of the photographic images are too specific, too figurative; the newly reworked pictures are meant to take somewhat of the subject reality.

Through a special technique he developed, he creates a type of vexier picture (picture puzzle) tending once towards the painted and then again to the photographic picture within a border where the flowing and the figurative images are combined.

Andreas Altmann, born 1960 in Vienna, has been photographing since childhood. He's held many exhibitions and projects. He opened his own studio in 2002. Since 2004, he has regularly been teaching "Digital Photography" in the summer academy on the Greek Island of Zakynthos.
